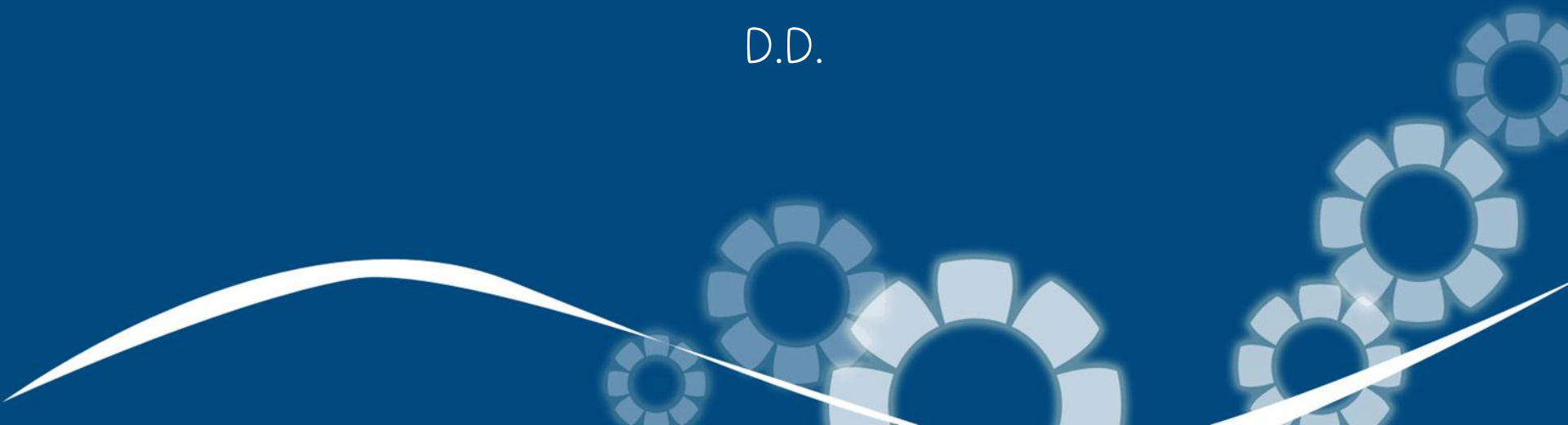
May this Eucharistic celebration unite us more deeply with one another as we share our life in communion with Jesus and through the loving accompaniment of Mary.

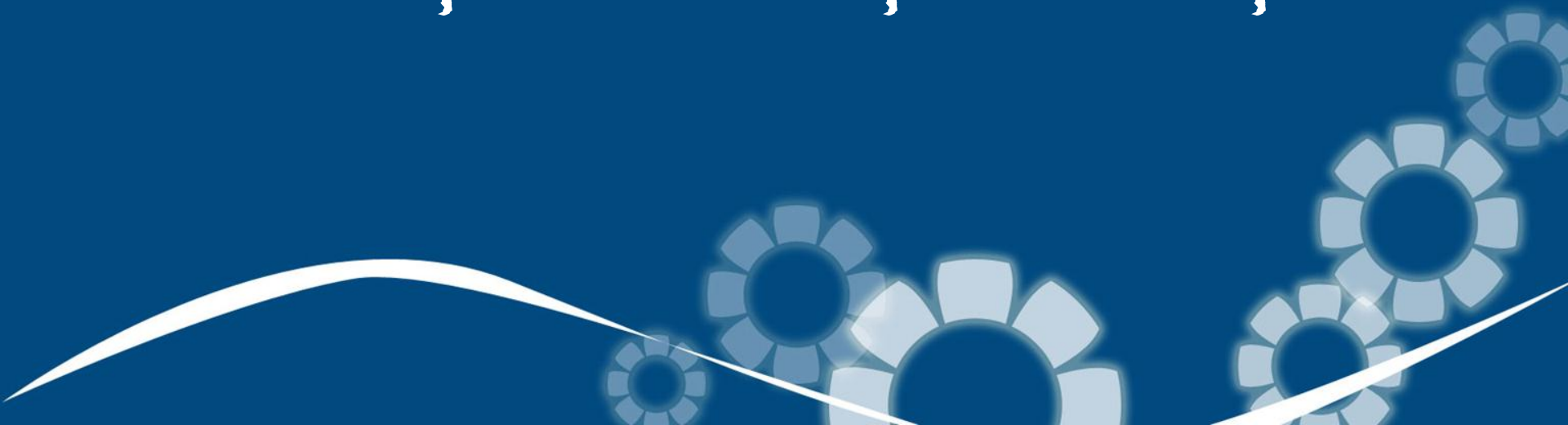
